Q: Do I need to register in advance?

A: There is a R.S.V.P link which can be found using the QR code. However, the event is free to attend and open to the general public!



Q: Who is this event intended for?

Q: Is this event wheelchair accessible?

Some amenities, such as the Event Centre, are accessible. Park pathways and parking areas are currently gravel.



Q: Are dogs allowed inside the Event Centre?

A: Only licenced service dogs are allowed inside.



Q: Is there a cost to attend?

Q: What happens if it is raining on event day?

A: Our event will take place rain or shine! If the weather doesn't cooperate, some outdoor activities may be moved indoors, or adjusted.
